


Christmas Message

On the fourth week of Advent, we light the final purple candle to mark the final week of prayer and penance as we wait for the birth of our Savior. This final candle, the "Angel's Candle," symbolizes peace. It reminds us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men." A Reminder of an Amazing Sharing. Paulo Coelho de Souza is a widely-read Brazilian Author and the Alchemist is his masterpiece. Jose's Sandal is one of his Christmas Tales and is a very moving story about amazing sharing. José's Sandals tells the story of José, a seven-year-old orphan in one of the southern villages of Brazil who an aunt adopted. The aunt lived in an affluent neighborhood and had more money than she needed to support her nephew. However, she wouldn't spend a penny on him. She gave him very little food to eat and wouldn't buy any new clothes for him. She ordered him to wear the same old clothes every day until he was ten. Since José had never known any love and kindness in his life from anybody, the maltreatment of his aunt didn't bother him. He thought people always treated their children this way. The aunt got José registered in a local school but refused to pay the standard tuition fees. When the principal demanded full tuition fees for José, she threatened to report to higher authorities, alleging discrimination. The threat had its desired effect as he did not expel José from school. He, nonetheless, instructed his teachers to humiliate José in every way so he would leave the school on his own. But José didn't bother about humiliation since he thought this was how people normally treated orphans. All the children in school except José always dressed properly and often wore fashionable clothes. Even though José wore ragged clothes and battered sandals, he always kept them neat and clean. However, the other children did not mingle with him as they knew he was dirt poor. Some children even told him that he was not welcome in their midst. Did it bother him? There were times he felt a tinge of sadness in his heart. Yet he consoled himself, saying it is the way life is. When the Advent Season arrived, people in his village started decorating their homes with Christmas stars and colorful ornaments. José wished he could do the same but never asked his aunt as he knew she would never permit such an extravagance. On Christmas Eve, all the school children went to church for Vigil Mass. They were all excited about the gifts they would get on Christmas day from their parents. They talked about new bicycles, delicious chocolates, and other expensive gifts. While everyone was having fun, José was lost in his thoughts as he entered the church. Glitter lights and Christmas decorations adorned the church. The pipe organ played the sacred song the angels sang when Jesus was born in Bethlehem two thousand years ago on a cold winter night. The children soon joined their families for the celebration of Mass. They all looked happy and cheerful. However, with no family and friends, José felt he was the most wretched of all creatures on earth. After Mass, when everyone went home, he did not walk back with them. Instead, he felt lonely and abandoned and sat on the church steps crying. Soon he noticed a little boy sitting next to him wearing ragged clothes and no sandals. "You walked to church with no sandals?" asked José. When the little boy nodded his head in agreement, José immediately gave one of his sandals to the little boy and asked him to wear it, thinking that it would take away at least half of his pain. José then ran home wearing only one sandal, afraid his aunt would be angry with him for being late. When he got home, his aunt was mad at him for being late and losing one of his sandals. He went to bed sad and hungry that night as she refused to serve him dinner as a punishment. But when he woke up in the morning, he couldn't believe his eyes. His room was filled with all kinds of toys and other expensive gifts. He also found his sandal, which he had given to the little boy the previous night. Soon the news reached him that people found a statue of Baby Jesus on the steps of the church clothed in gold but wearing only one sandal. Immediately, José felt he was the most blessed person on the earth! When his aunt found out what happened, she begged forgiveness and thanked José for reminding her of the true spirit of Christmas. Christmas is a great reminder of the amazing sharing by God. José, even though he was an orphan and penniless, knew how to share what he had with others. He had only a pair of battered sandals. Nevertheless, when he found another boy without sandals, he gave away one, hoping it would alleviate at least half of his pain. José had the true spirit of Christmas. This is the kind of Christmas spirit we should all have. If we have this kind of Christmas spirit, our world will become a better place for everyone, and there will be peace on earth permanently. I wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy Healthy New Year.


